LOOKING FOR Dogs with Kidney Disease

Purpose of Study:

- We want to know if dogs who have kidney disease and take gabapentin have difference blood pressure responses than dogs without kidney disease.

Eligible Dogs:

- Dogs with IRIS stage 2 or 3, stable kidney disease.
- Normal or stable and controlled blood pressure.
- Any age or breed.
- Free from other diseases requiring medications.

Benefits:

- Free physical exam, CBC , chemistry profile and blood pressure.
- Help science and dogs!

Study Requirements:

- This study requires 3 visits.
- Visit 1 will confirm eligibility with a physical exam and lab tests.
- Visits 2 and 3 will be 1 week apart and will involve 4 hours spent at the hospital to have blood pressure monitored after administration of either gabapentin or placebo (1 visit for each, blinded).
