



LOOKING FOR Dogs with naïve lymphoma

Studying safety and efficacy of Laverdia/CCNU to treat lymphoma

Is my dog eligible?

- Any age, breed, and sex of dog that is > 10kg.
- Dogs need a confirmed diagnosis of lymphoma.
- The lymphoma needs to have been determined to be B-cell or T-cell via flow cytometry.
- Dogs cannot have had any treatment for lymphoma including chemotherapy, corticosteroids (prednisone), or immunosuppressants.
- Dogs cannot have other severe diseases.

What is covered?

- The treatment period requires visits to UW Vet Care on weeks 0, 3, 6, 9, 12, and 15.
- The cost of recheck exams, lab work, and medications administered at these visits are paid for by the study.

What is not covered?

- Cost of initial appointment and diagnosis confirmation.
- Supportive medications needed due to side effects of treatment.
- Visits or testing done by your regular veterinarian.
