LOOKING FOR Cats with FIP

Studying response to FIP treatment options

The Study

We are comparing treatment response in cats diagnosed with FIP to learn if there is a difference in response to different medications.

If your cat is diagnosed with, and treated for, FIP, we will follow up with surveys to determine your cats response to treatment over the next 6 months.

Who Qualifies

We are enrolling cats with FIP (either confirmed or suspected) before starting treatment. Your cat must be a patient at UWVC, so has to come to UWVC at least once prior to beginning treatment.

Diagnostic testing and treatment options will be discussed with your UWVC veterinarian at the time of enrollment.

Why Participate

The study pays for an FIP PCR and an FIP Antigen test to be run on samples collected by your UWVC veterinarian (\$300-400 value).

If your cat is prescribed treatment for FIP you will get \$500 off your UWVC bill.

Treatment groups are one group will receive entirely GS treatment and the other will receive in hospital remdesivir + GS treatment for the remainder.
