Join our study!

Study Purpose

- This study will compare environmental modification alone to environmental modification plus a once/month injection of Solensia™.

Eligibility

- Adult cats who have had an episode of feline idiopathic cystitis (FIC) in the past 6 months.
- Other causes have been ruled out with a physical exam, bloodwork, urinalysis with culture, and abdominal ultrasound.

Incentives

- Free screening exam, bloodwork, and ultrasound.
- Multimodal environmental modification recommendations for all cats.
- All study materials are paid for.
- Possible improvement of feline idiopathic cystitis symptoms.

Study Visits

- You will have a screening visit plus once/month visits for 6 months.
- Your cat may receive gabapentin, if desired, for visit related anxiety.
- Your cat will have a physical exam and blood and urine collected at each visit plus an injection under the skin.
- You will fill out a survey while you wait for your cat's exam and treatment.
- If your cat has a reaction to the treatment or a recurrent FIC episode, they will end the study at that point.
