DOES YOUR DOG HAVE APOCRINE GLAND ANAL SAC ADENOCARCINOMA?

Purpose of Study:

To determine the utility of PET/CT for identifying cancer spread in dogs with AGASACA.

Eligible Dogs:

Any dog diagnosed with AGASACA by cytology who has not started treatment.

Benefits:

FREE PET/CT. All costs associated with the PET/CT are covered by the study.

Help future dogs with AGASACA.

Study Requirements:

You will be responsible for the cost of a prior diagnosis, any additional diagnostics, and medications to go home.

Be willing to drop your dog off at UW Veterinary Care, in Madison, for 1 day. They will undergo PET / CT under general anesthesia.
